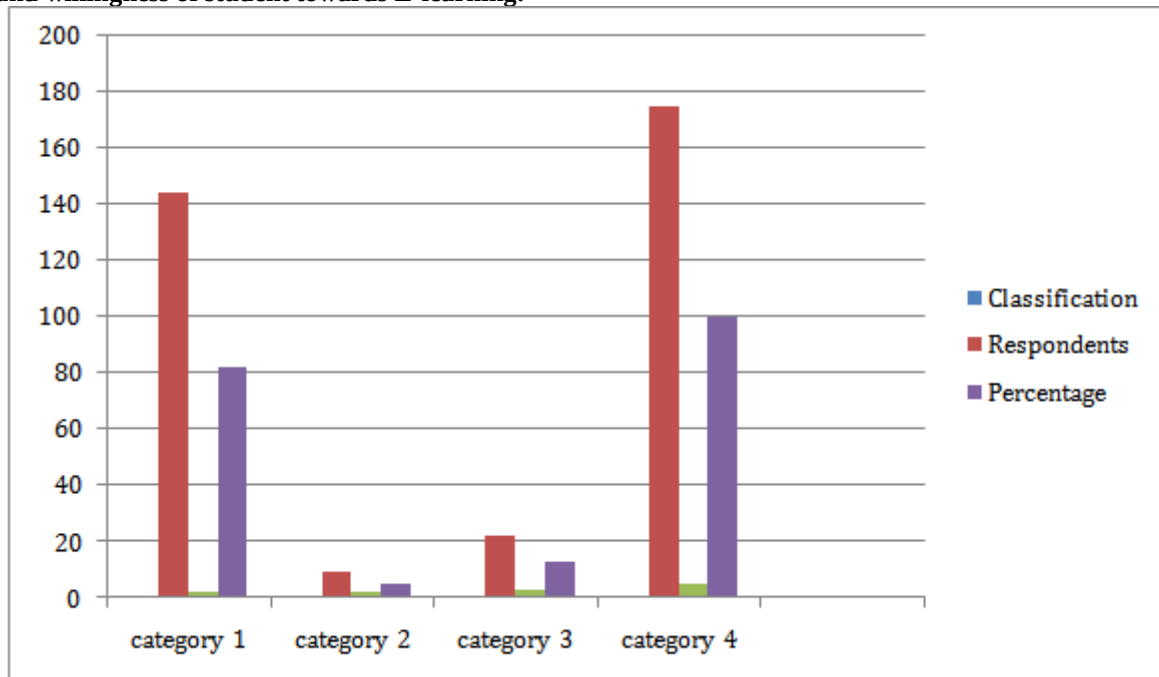

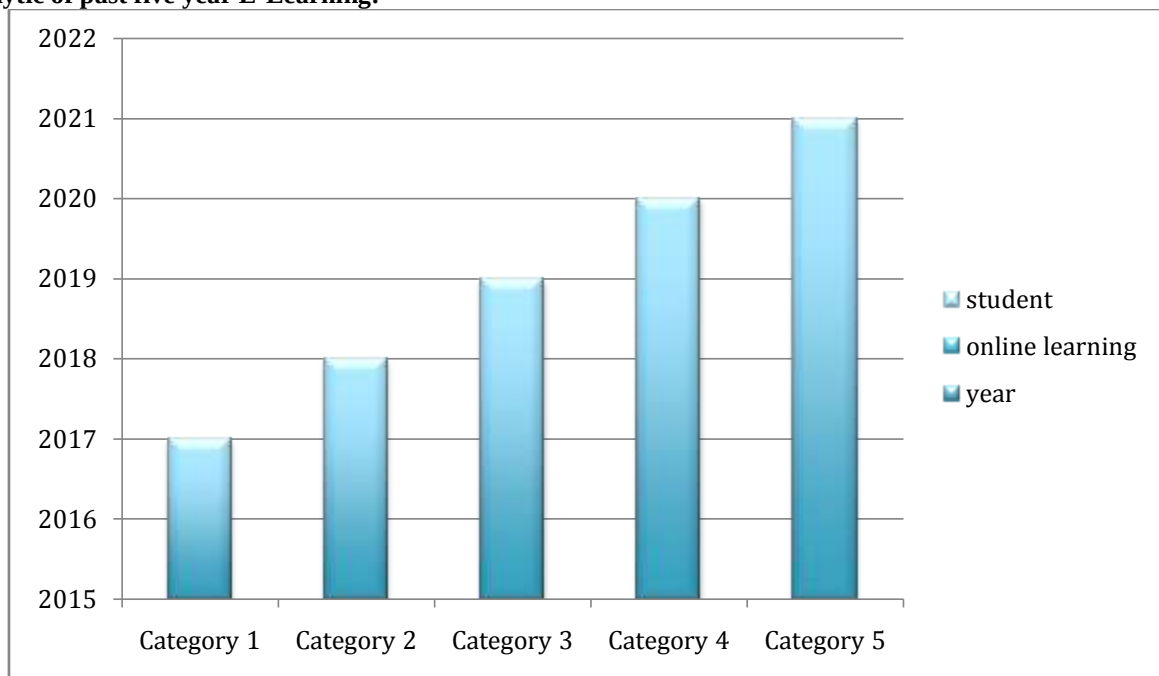


Analysis and willingness of student towards E-learning:
